## DOS EQUIS PAVILION (FORMERLY GEXA ENERGY PAVILION)

Just about anyone in Dallas who loves music has an unforgettable memory about this special place.

Built in 1988, this outdoor amphitheater is Dallas's premier venue for musical concerts under the stars. Over the years, it has hosted memorable performances by a varied group of artists, including Elton John, The Police, Brad Paisley, Tina Turner, Martina McBride, Coldplay, Santana, and Black Sabbath among many others.

The facility's stage/production area and covered pavilion seat 7,533 persons. A sloping lawn beyond the pavilion accommodates another 12,578. In all, more than 6 million patrons have attended the more than 600 concerts the center has hosted.

One interesting piece of trivia: the center has occasionally gone beyond its traditional role as a concert venue. For example, in 1994, ten episodes of the popular game show Wheel of Fortune were filmed here with a live audience.
